## FGPC: one year

- A new padding club founded by the Victoria Dragon Boat Festival Society in February 2014
- Formed to promote paddling sports in Greater Victoria, Vancouver Island and beyond
- Rapid but sustainable growth in the club's first year





## FGPC: year two

- 1200 program paddlers (dragon boat and outrigger)
- 3,000 kayak and SUP rentals
- 300 kids (aged 6-12) participating in FGPC week-long "kids camps" throughout the summer
- 2,000 school-aged kids participating in dragon boat and outrigger adventures during the summer season
