Presentation: Jordan Welch on The Ocean Clean-Up

- Starting operations in Victoria around July 20th.
- Cleaning up plastic waste in the ocean(s).
- Around 80 personnel in the company.
- Funded through philanthropy.
- 46% of ocean's debris is fishing nets (by weight).
- Nets can only be recycled in Europe. Not offered in North America.
- Great Pacific Garbage Patch in Pacific Ocean is now twice the size of Texas.
- One six week trip confirmed. Subsequent trips will be dependent on success/weather etc for up to three missions.
- Very complicated system on the boats to ensure they get the ocean plastics that are not only floating, but also plastics that don't float to the surface.

- Western Stevedoring plans to welcome the group with open arms. We want Victoria and Ogden Point to be a preferred port.
- Expect a media frenzy when they come back after six weeks with a load of recycling.
- No goal set up for how much they think they'll bring back.
- Two ships total.

Some products that can be made from the recycled product:

Sunglasses (\$200/pair!)

Operations in Victoria in include:

- Provisions supply
- Wiring
- Welding
- Blowing up booms
- Stenciling/branding the vessel
